### **FCSO Deputies Investigating Two Sunday Incidents**

Flagler County Sheriff's deputies were busy Sunday responding to reported gunfire at a Palm Coast home and, in a separate incident, the armed robbery of a local liquor store.

Around 2 a.m. Sunday, deputies responded to 14B Buttwood Lane in Palm Coast after receiving reports of shots being fired into the home. The occupants of the unit told deputies that two black males came by around 10 p.m. Saturday looking for another man. The two said they were owed money. After being turned away, the men came back around 2 a.m. The residents said they saw them walking up the drive with one armed with a gun.

A female resident was outside when the two approached. She was grabbed by her hair and ordered to open the door to the residence. The male then fired several shots into the air and released the woman. The man then went to the front window and fired several rounds into the residence. Deputies recovered seven shell casings from the driveway, front yard and porch area. It appeared another five to seven rounds were fired into the residence.

The assailants left in a newer model pickup truck.

In a separate incident, deputies were dispatched to the Sharps Liquor Store in Flagler Regional Plaza on State Road 100 around 10:36 a.m. in response to a reported armed robbery.

Deputies said a store customer called deputies after he found the store door locked and heard the cashier screaming for help.

The clerk told deputies that a black male came in the store and asked for help finding an item. He was wearing a helmet, riding jacket and gloves. The clerk said the man grabbed her and ordered her at gunpoint to open the register and safe. He then took the money,

made her lock the door and ordered her into the stock room where he bound her legs and hands. The robber reportedly fled out of the store's back door.
