### **Flagler Sheriff's Deputy Opens Cubs Game**

Last year, during the Labor Day weekend, Flagler County Sheriff's Deputy Mark Reeves arrested 15 motorists for impaired driving.

His efforts to keep the roads safe will be recognized tonight when he throws out the first pitch of the game for the Daytona Cubs at Jackie Robinson Stadium at 7 p.m.

The Florida Department of Transportation and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration has recognized Deputy Reeves as "Flagler County's TOP DUI Enforcement Officer" for the 2010 Labor Day holiday period.

"I am proud of the deputies who work so hard to keep our roads safe. Deputy Reeves has been dedicated to this DUI education and enforcement effort; that dedication has paid off with this recognition. I congratulate him on a job well done," said Flagler County Sheriff Donald W. Fleming.

Through coordinated efforts by the FCSO to reduce impaired driving on our local highways, Flagler County has seen a reduction in crashes resulting in injury and fatalities. The agency efforts have also paid off with increased DUI arrests and an increase in seat belt compliance. Flagler County has an average of 90 percent compliance with safety belt requirements, one of the highest in the Nation.

The FCSO motorcycle unit placed fourth out of 100 motor units across the state for the 2010 Motor Unit Enforcement Challenge.

Deputy Reeves joined the agency in 2007.
