Flagler County Sheriff's dispatchers issued a BOLO at 11:43 a.m. that was received from the Ormond Beach Police Department in reference to an armed robbery of a pharmacy at 500 West Granada Blvd.

Property taken in the robbery included numerous amounts of prescription pills. The suspects reportedly fled in a mid-size light-color sedan. Initial reports stated the suspects were three black males who were armed with handguns.

While on patrol, Bunnell units attempted to stop a vehicle matching that description on U.S. 1 and Belle Terre Parkway. The vehicle sped away in an attempt to elude the two Bunnell Officers and a small pursuit ensued until the car crashed at the end of a Cul-de-sac on Zoeller Court. The three subjects exited on foot with one being apprehended at the crash scene by a Bunnell police officer. The other two suspects fled into the woods. FCSO units responded and established a perimeter. An FCSO K-9 unit and Fireflight responded to assist in locating the other two subjects who were still armed. On-duty SWAT members responded to assist with K-9 in the search.

One suspect was located by FCSO deputies hiding on the back porch of a residence on Zoeller Court. He had concealed himself under some blankets on the outside lanai of the home.

In an attempt to locate the last suspect, a K-9 track was conducted from the suspect vehicle. After approximately 10-minutes of tracking, the last suspect was located in a wooded area and taken into custody without incident.

During the search for the suspect, two hand guns and most of the stolen prescription pills were located in the wooded area.

Ormond PD investigators and FCSO CID responded to collect evidence and interview the subjects.

All three subjects were released to the custody of the Ormond Beach Police Department.
